Rep. Natalie Mihalek and Sen. Devlin Robinson invite you to receive assistance with popular services such as applying for the Property Tax and Rent Rebate, a PRT Senior Connect Card, or reclaiming unclaimed property! Identification and supporting documentation may be required.



Property Tax and Rent Rebate

Retirees over 65, widows over 50, and adults with disabilities whose 2025 income was up to \$48,110 (counting half of an applicants' Social Security) are eligible to receive a rebate up to \$1,000. Applicants should have proof of all income, 2025 property tax receipts, as well as the PA Rent Certificate form in the Department of Revenue's PA-1000 booklet.



Pittsburgh Regional Transit Senior Connect Card

Available to seniors 65 and older, PRT Senior Citizen Connect Card holders can access public transit systems across Pennsylvania for free. Applicants must bring proof of age such as a driver's license, birth certificate, or passport.



Unclaimed Property

Unclaimed property turned over to the Pennsylvania Treasury may include dormant bank accounts, abandoned stocks, and uncashed checks. You can find out if there is unclaimed property available to you by visiting Treasury's unclaimed property database at patreasury.gov or have staff at the event search for you. Identification is required as well as documentation demonstrating the applicant is entitled to the unclaimed property.
